The Traill County Commissioners came to order on April 3, 2018 with the following members present: Commissioners Eblen, Young, Nesvig, Elliott and Commissioner Amb by conference call. MINUTES: On motion of Eblen, seconded by Nesvig and carried to approve the minutes of March 20, 2018 as presented.

NOTICES: Invite to the NDIRF annual meeting to be held on 05-17-18 in Bismarck. Commissioners Young and Elliott will assist in the interviewing process for the Deputy Treasurer set for April 23, 2018.

HIGHWAY PATROL: On motion of Eblen, seconded by Elliott and carried to allow the County Auditor to send a request to the ND Highway Patrol for assistance in enforcing the load restrictions on all Traill County roads.

TAX DIRECTOR: Kayla Knudson, Tax Director presented two applications for tax exemption on new homes. On motion of Elliott, seconded by Eblen and carried to approve the applications for parcels #04-0000-00469-025 and parcel #04-0000-00486-030. Both parcels located in Bloomfield Township.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT: Corwyn Martin, Road Superintendent met with the Board. Informed the Board of a snow plow that was damaged when it hit the rail road tracks. County Road 81 bid deadline is April 9, 2018. Code 3 Bridge report from the state has been received and reviewed. Martin received a reply from the ND DOT concerning the changes being proposed for the intersections of ND Highway 18 and Traill County highways 9 and 14. The state is claiming that changes to this intersection will improve safety. Martin will try and set up a meeting with the State Department and Commissioners to discuss the intersection changes. On motion of Eblen, seconded by Amb and carried to approve a County Road/Right-of-Way Encroachment and Crossing Permit filed by Minnkota Power Company for an above ground electric transmission line along County Road #13 in the SE ¼ of section 17 and NE ¼ of 20 in Eldorado Township. On motion of Nesvig, seconded by Elliott and carried to renew the ditch cleaning permit for Haugen Farms on County Road 16 in sections 3 & 10 of Roseville Township that was filed in 2017 because the work was not completed.

BIDS: (1) GRAVEL BIDS: On motion of Eblen, seconded by Amb and carried to open gravel bids which were received from KRB Gravel, Mayville; JC & J Trucking, Bejou MN; Lakeside Construction, Finley; Paulson Gravel, Mayville and Gowan Construction, Oslo MN. On motion of Amb, seconded by Nesvig and carried to have Martin review the bids and report back at the next meeting. (2) BITUMINOUS OIL BIDS: On motion of Elliott, seconded by Eblen and carried to open bituminous oil bids received from Flint Hills Resources, West Fargo and Husky Energy-Superior Refinery, Wisconsin. On motion of Elliott, seconded by Eblen and carried to have Martin review the bids and report back at the next meeting. UND/GAME & FISH/TRAILL COUNTY AGREEMENT: Jason Boulanger, UND Assistant Professor Wildlife Ecology & Human Dimensions. Mr. Boulanger presented a 5 year agreement between UND, ND Game & Fish and Traill County for use of land owned by Traill County located in the SE ¼ of 18-147-50 for purposes of establishing a Traill County Biology Station and Wildlife Management Area. After much discussion, Mr. Boulanger will have his legal counsel add a paragraph pertaining to emergency use of the gravel pit by Traill County and present the updated contract to Traill County's legal counsel and Commissioners for approval at a future date.

2019 SALARY DISCUSSION: It was decided to have the Auditor send a note to all departments requesting them to reserve a time to meet with the Commissioners to discuss the 2019 salaries only. Salary meetings will start at 9:00 a.m. on April 17, 2018. Future meetings will be scheduled for late June early July to discuss the rest of their budgets.
