The Traill County Commissioners came to order on March 5, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. with the following members present: Commissioners Eblen, Nesvig, Amb and Young, Commissioner Elliott absent. On motion of Nesvig, seconded by Young and carried to approve the minutes of 02-19-119 as presented.

IDEMNITY BOND: On motion of Young, seconded by Eblen and carried to approve the Indemnity Bond on Lost Instrument for the Traill County Tribune, Auditor's Warrant #95897 in the amount of \$954.20.

LIQUOR/BEER LICENSE: On motion of Nesvig, seconded by Young and carried to approve and allow the Chairman and Auditor to sign the ON SALE ONLY liquor and beer licenses for The Goose River Golf Club, applications to run May 1, 2019 thru November 30, 2019.

JOB SHADOWING: On motion of Eblen, seconded by Young and carried to partner with the Career and Technical Education Department at Central Valley Public School.

COUNTY GOVERNMENT MONTH: On April 30, 2019 from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm the Traill County Courthouse will serve coffee and goodies in honor of County Government month, with more details to come at a later date.

LOAD RESTRICTIONS: On motion of Eblen, seconded by Nesvig and carried to allow the County Auditor to send a letter to the ND Highway Patrol asking for year-round assistance for enforcing the load restrictions on all Traill County roads.

CORRESPONDENCE: Received the February 2019 minutes & financial documents of the Agassiz Valley Social Service District. Received a copy of the NDACo news release concerning the purchasing of election equipment.

RAFFLE PERMIT: On motion of Eblen, seconded by Young and carried to approve the raffle permit filed by Stordahl WELCA for a drawing to be held on 04-24-19.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT: Corwyn Martin, Road Superintendent discussed the yearly road report, it is costly and takes a lot of time to print and assemble. Commissioners agreed that no paper report needs to be given but have the information on file should anyone request it. Martin informed the Commission that Grand Forks County finalized the load limit increase and is allowing 129,000 load limits. On motion of Nesvig, seconded by Eblen and carried to allow the Chairman and County Auditor to sign a County Road/Right-Of-Way Encroachment and Crossing Permit filed by Midcontinent Communications for fiber optic cable to be installed on south side of CR 16 in sections 34 & 35 in Township 146 Range 53 (Roseville Township). Matt Lange & Scott Smyth engineers with KLJ met with the board. Lange informed the Board there was no word on the NDDOT Discretionary Bridge Grant as of today. On motion of Young, seconded by Nesvig and carried to allow the Chairman to sign an Agreement for Engineering Services with KLJ for County Roads 11 and 17, once Charlie Stock, States Attorney has reviewed the contract, the Auditor can send it to KLJ.

INSURANCE BIDS: Lee Erickson met with the board. On motion of Eblen, seconded by Young and carried to open bids. One bid was received from Erickson Agency for a period of 04-01-19 to 04-01-20. On motion of Nesvig, seconded by Young and carried to accept the bid in the amount of \$64,458.00. The Hartford Steam Boiler policy will be mailed to us separately, in 2018-2019 the boiler policy ran \$2,288.00. Commissioners requested Erickson to check into insuring the county computers and equipment that travel outside of the office and bring back the information to the next meeting.

SHERIFF: Steve Hunt, Sheriff informed the Board of the potential of flooding for this spring. New squad car is here. Discussed the old car to be put up for sale at a later date.

HUMAN RESOURCES: Heather Hovey, Deputy Auditor presented information of a Health Insurance feasibility study with NDIRF and Premier Benefits Group, Inc. On motion of Eblen, seconded by Nesvig and carried to allow the

chairman to sign the agreement at no cost to the county. Hovey also presented a "Security/Confidentiality Statement" which has been given to all employees, department heads and elected officials to review and sign.

HILLSBORO CITY: Matt Mutzenberger, Hillsboro City Auditor asked for Traill County support for Hillsboro City's project and explained the Automated Vehicle "AV", bus service. The Commissioners were invited to an open meeting on Monday, March 11, 2019 at 6:30 in the Hillsboro Community Center.
