The Traill County Park Board met on June 4, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Commissioners Thomas Eblen, Kurt Elliott, Kendall Nesvig, Larry Young and Les Amb and Glenda Haugen, County Auditor.

Haugen notified the board that all utilities should be up and running. Nesvig said the dumpster was not there as of today. Haugen will contact Waste Management again. Corwyn Martin, Road Superintendent said the mower is back at the park and his department did some work on the road.

Discussion was held on the 2020 budget for the County Park and whether to have the park open next year. Commissioners will wait until after this summer months to see if having someone physically living at the park, to watch over the park, will help curve unwanted activity. Sheriff Hunt informed the board he has already had one arrest in the County Park since it opened about a week ago.

On motion of Eblen, seconded by Young and carried to have Haugen request \$10,000 for the 2020 Park budget. The budgets will not be formalized until early October.
