The Traill County Commissioners came to order on February 15, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. with the following members present: Commissioners Eblen, Elliott and Young. Commissioner Amb attended via Webex. Commissioner Nesvig absent and not voting. Request to add Jill Murphy, Extension Agent to agenda. On motion of Eblen, seconded by Elliott and carried to approve the amended agenda. On motion of Eblen, seconded by Amb and carried to approve the minutes of 02-02-22.

EXTENSION AGENT: Jill Murphy, Extension Agent introduced her new administrative secretary Katie Mueller and updated the board on various trainings and meetings coming up.

AUDITOR: Glenda Haugen, Auditor requested to close her office for statewide election training the afternoon of Wednesday, March 2nd, all day on March 3rd and 4th, 2022, with Treasurer's office taking calls. On motion of Amb, seconded by Elliott and carried to grant the request.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT: Corwyn Martin, Road Superintendent and Matt Lange, KLJ Engineer updated the board on various issues. Lange & Martin are requesting to move Bridge 2 to the Federal Aid Project listing as additional HB1505 funds will be available from the state. On motion of Amb, seconded by Eblen and carried to approve the request. The State DOT has approved bridge #231 and #316 for repairs with funds from the HB1505.

CLERK OF DISTRICT COURT: Jody Schill, Clerk of District Court requested to continue the funding agreement with the State Supreme Court which provides funding to help with salaries and operational needs for her office. Options are to continue with the agreement, keeping the control at the county level, or elect to have the clerk and staff become employees of the state judicial system giving control to the state. On motion of Eblen, seconded by Elliott and carried to continue with state reimbursements with the county in control of the office.

HILLSBORO CITY/CALEDONIA AVENUE: Terry Sando, Hillsboro Commission President; Jim Anderson, Hillsboro City Public Works Supervisor; Dave Sather, Hillsboro Commissioner and Tyler Amiot representing AE2S met with the board to discuss Caledonia Avenue repairs. Hillsboro City is looking to repair, resurface, and make ADA improvements to their streets. Hillsboro representatives are asking the county to pay a portion of Caledonia Avenue repairs in addition to the special assessments which would be incurred as the county owns property in the areas that will be resurfaced. Hillsboro City is estimating the cost to repair Caledonia Avenue could cost the city \$530,000.00. No motions or agreements were discussed at this time.
