

# Trail County Highway Department

## Dust Control policy

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All dust control in Traill County is done by private contractors being negotiated between the different contractors (suppliers) and the individuals wanting the service. Traill County does not provide dust control.

Traill County property owners and residents are required to first obtain a permit to apply dust control agents to county roads at least 1 week prior to application. Only approved products shall be applied to county roads. All permits expire OCT 1 of each year

Flag markers must be placed at each end of the treated surface, readily visible to the patrol operators so the treated area is not bladed. Markers must be 3 foot tall with colored material attached that is easily visible. Traill County does not provide flag markers.

If the treated area develops potholes the applicant is responsible for maintenance of the potholes. If not properly maintained, the county reserves the right to smooth and maintain at the patrol operators discretion.
