The meeting was called to order by President Jill Anderson.

Minutes of the 1/29/18 meeting were approved. (Gunderson/Breen)

Financial statements and expenses for 1/1/18 - 3/31/18 were approved as distributed (Breen/Gunderson).

Stallman reviewed the 2017 Report of Activities.

Stallman provided an update and a Rural Leadership ND newsletter describing the Washington DC seminar attended recently.

The Great Plains Food Bank provides extra food for children that do not have adequate food for weekends through schools in Mayville and Hatton. They wish to expand the program in to Hillsboro. Stallman met with Hillsboro Elementary School Principal, Jon Dryburgh, and Counselor, Jill Anderson about the possibility. Both were in favor and will discuss steps of implementation with Great Plains.

Stallman has registered to take the Mental Health First Aid Course. There are multiple modules for the course, including Adult, Youth, and Rural. Following completion of the modules, she hopes to become a trainer so the course can be presented locally.

A brief overview of the Community Health Assessment conducted by Sanford Health was discussed. Access to Mental Health services and availability of quality childcare continue to be key priorities.

Stallman presented the 2019 budget. Moved by Amb, seconded by Gunderson to accept the proposed budget.

Stallman covered key components of the ND medical marijuana law. State Health officials predict medical marijuana will be available in ND by the end of this year.
