## **Snagging & Clearing:**

### Stavanger-Belmont No. 52:

Contractor JAV Construction will be replacing culverts and installing a new headwall once the snow/ice melts.

## Hillsboro Drain No. 26:

A water-shed delineation will be performed by our engineer to determine the stream crossing standards to replace a culvert in Section 34 of Eldorado Township and Section 3 of Hillsboro Township on County Road 3. This information was requested by the County Highway Department.

#### Greenfield-Bohnsack Drain #57A:

The Application for Surface Drain No. 5243 was reviewed by the Office of the State Engineer. Upon review, the OSE has determined that the proposed drainage under this Application is not drainage of statewide or inter-district significance. Therefore, the OSE is referring this application to our office for review as required. After review and discussion, Manager Lovas moved to approve Application No. 5243.
