The Traill County Commissioners came to order on May 7, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. with all member present. On motion of Nesvig, seconded by Eblen and carried to approve the minutes of 04-16-19 as presented.

HANDOUTS: Received a copy of the 2017 final audit for Traill County. Received the Agassiz Valley Social Services District Board minutes and financials for April 2019.

MUD ON ROAD: A meeting is set up for May 21, 2019 at 10:00 with Charlie Stock, States Attorney, Commissioners Ken Nesvig and Larry Young and Corwyn Martin and they will report back to the commission on June 4, 2019.

FEMA-PRAIRIE LAND: Commissioners instructed the Auditor to invite representatives from Hillsboro City Park, Hillsboro Horse Pull event & the Glen Hultin family to discuss the land owned by Traill County.

HEALTH INSURANCE: Received the new NDPERS health insurance rates for the County which starts 07-01-19 and runs thru 06-30-21. The single policy, which is paid by the county will be \$733.68 monthly. The family policy will run \$1,773.60, with the employees being responsible to pay \$1,039.92 monthly.

TAX DIRECTOR: Kayla Knudson, Tax Director presented tax abatements filed by Jamie Rue for 2017 & 2018. The reason for the abatements was because the house was assessed on the wrong parcel. On motion of Eblen, seconded by Young and carried to approve the abatements for parcel #04-0000-00567-020.

AMBULANCE BUDGET: Stefan Hofer, Director for West Traill Ambulance met with the board. He is looking at a different approach to the budgeting process, which may save some money. Commissioners instructed Hofer to submit his request and it will be reviewed during the regular budget discussions. County Auditor requested a most current copy of the West Traill Ambulance audit to be filed in the office.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT: Corwyn Martin, Road Superintendent and Matt Lange, KLJ gave updates to the Board. On motion of Nesvig, seconded by Elliott and carried to allow the Chairman & County Auditor to sign the agreements with the following: Lakeside Construction, Paulson Gravel and True North Steel. Martin presented the 2018 Annual Highway Report. Lange presented bids for the Bridge 122 paving project. On motion of Young, seconded by Elliott and carried to accept the bid from Handcock Concrete Products in the amount of \$58,811.76. Martin was instructed to consult with Charlie Stock, States attorney concerning two gravel bids received after the deadline and bring back to the Commission. Martin informed the board he will be hiring a seasonal employee to help in the office. On motion of Elliott, seconded by Eblen and carried to approve the Encroachment and Crossing permit submitted by Judith Olson along county road #2, in Caledonia Township. No dates have been set for removal of the load limits.

DIASTER 2019 (FEMA-DES): Martin informed the Board that DES (formally FEMA) has approved the 2019 Disaster which requires at least \$30,000.00 in damage, which the townships and county will exceed the minimum requirement. Martin is meeting with the inspectors today.

SHERIFF: Steve Hunt, Sheriff presented a quote for replacement of two sheriff vehicles, one for the county and the other for Mayville City. On motion of Eblen, seconded by Nesvig and carried to approve the quote from Nelson Motors, Fergus Falls MN in the amount of \$33,591.34 for each vehicle. Mayville City already approved the amount for their vehicle. Hunt informed the board that the maintenance cost to the fingerprint machine is increasing.

AUDITOR: Glenda Haugen informed the board that Stacy Smelden will be starting on May 20, 2019 as the new Deputy Auditor. Haugen also requested direction from the board for setting salaries for the 2020 budget year. The Commission was in agreement to ask the departments to place a 3% salary increase in their proposed budget, however, no salary increases will be decided until the budget process starts later this summer.
